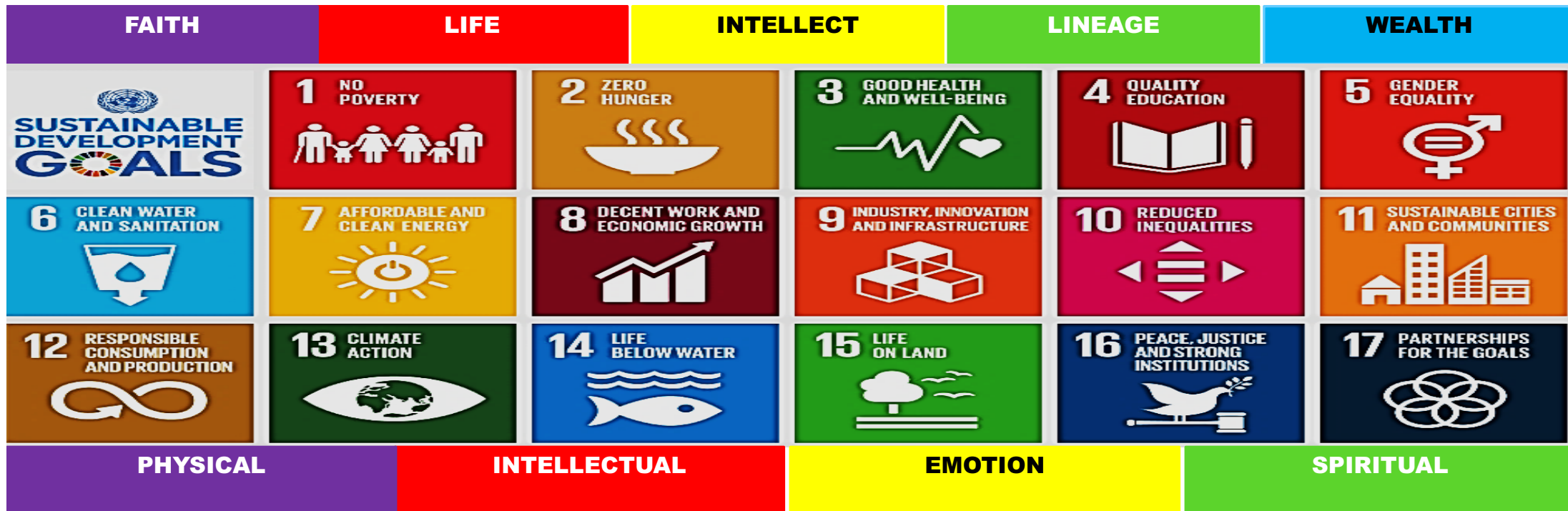
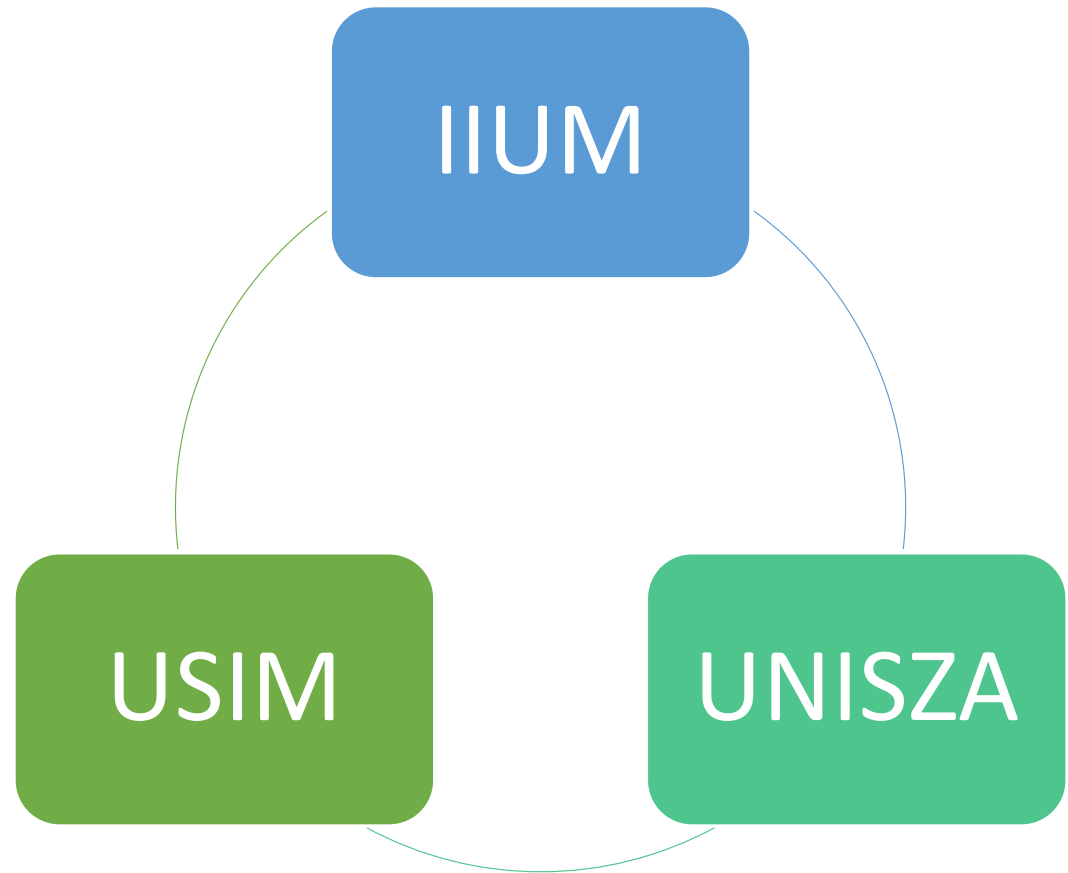

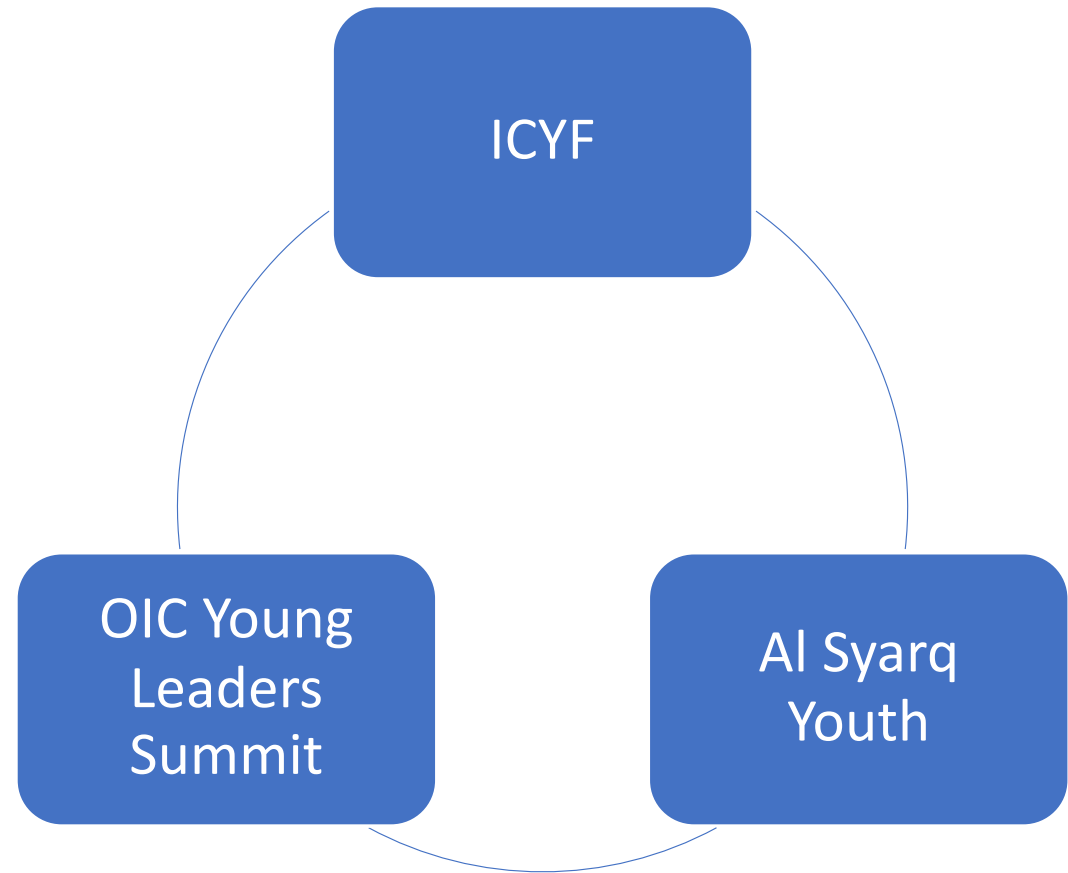

Every two years all Member come together to discuss and debate thematic areas of concern.

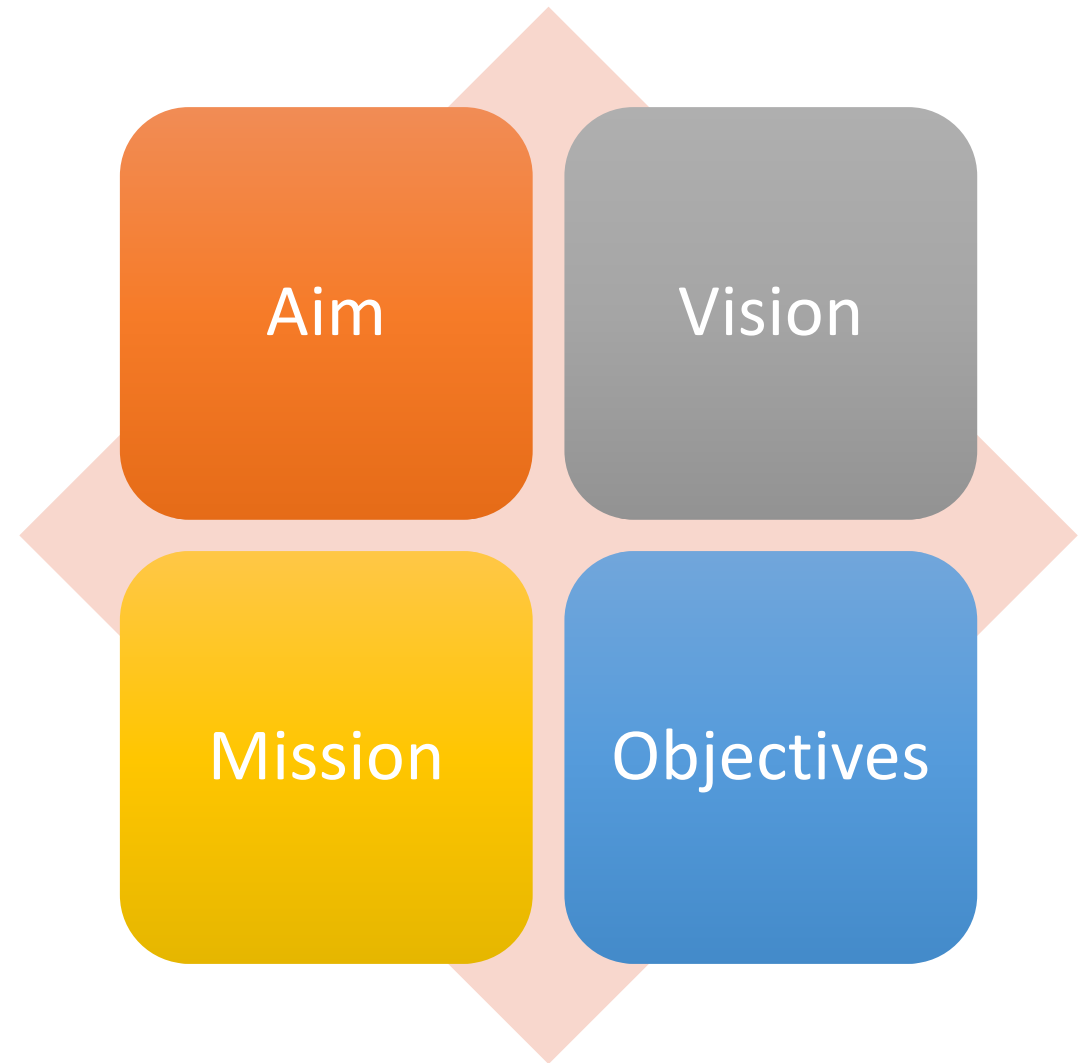


The forum culminates in a series of recommended actions to be presented and submitted at relevant authorities.



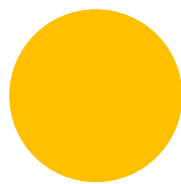
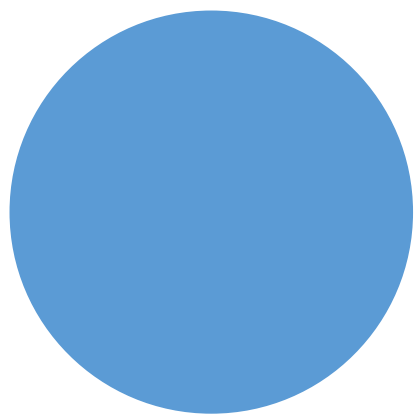
