

Convergence of Global Crises- fuelled by conflict, ideological shifts, demographic changes, climate change and food insecurity.

Climate change and Pandemic- Reduce available food and water resources, increase migration, raise tensions, and trigger new conflicts. **'Environmental refugees'**, 150 million by 2050. The number of forcibly displaced persons has grown to more than 70 million due to new and protracted conflicts.




Thinking Framework


